SUPPLIES are available at Michael's or JoAnn's:

• Crochet Hook: Size I - also known as I-9

I recommend aluminum crochet hooks by Susan Bates or Boye, or Crystalites hooks by Susan Bates. Lion Brand plastic hooks are okay, as well.

<u>Note</u>: If you can't find a size "I" hook, size J-10 will work.

• Yarn to make a scarf:

Purchase 2 balls of yarn, 100% acrylic with a number "4" rating on the label in the same color (solid not multicolored)



Here is a list of possible brands:

The "pound" yarns are fine, but you really don't need that much yarn so you might want to choose something else on the worsted weight list.

- <u>Note 1</u>: Choose <u>lighter colors</u> -- they are ideal when learning because you can see the stitches better. **Do not buy** multicolored, "soft", "satin", or textured/nubby yarns they are difficult to manage for beginners.
- Additional Items: <u>Scissors</u> & <u>reading glasses</u> if you need them.

OPTIONAL Additional Project

Purchase 2 additional balls of yarn from the list above in a different color for another scarf to be presented in class using a different stitch technique that you may want to work on.
