Snow Blossom Hat with Pompom



Are you tired of making scarves and ready to learn something new? If so, this class will help take your crochet skills to the next level with a fun new project. Inspired by the USA Olympic snowboarding team, you'll learn to make this chunky winter hat along with an optional matching pompom. This advanced beginner level pattern utilizes a combination of a new stitch and technique, which creates a cool ribbed "knitted" look. Instructions will also be given on how to use stitch markers, work a slip stitch join row, and, of course, create a fluffy pompom. View project photos at www.ReneeJewelryClasses.com.

Materials: Please bring a size "L" crochet hook and two skeins of yarn in the color of your choice of either of the following brands: Loops & Threads "Charisma" from Michaels, or Bernat "Softie Chunky" from Joann. Note: very dark colors are not recommended.

Prerequisite: You must have some experience with crochet and have made a couple of scarves. Knowledge of the following stitches is required: chain, single and double crochet.
